Please arrive 15 minutes early to get checked in. To stay organized, we kindly ask that you attend skill assessment at the appropriate time slot. Players should bring their glove, bat and a helmet. We will have bats and helmets for players who might not have their own. Baseball attire (including cleats) is not required.

Note: This is not a tryout as there are no "cuts" in Little League. A skill assessment is performed to:

- 1. ensure your child is placed at the appropriate level.
- 2. achieve a proper skill balance among teams.

Important Notes:

- Failure to attend skill assessment means that your child may not be placed at the appropriate level.
- League Age 8 and 9 year olds may not be considered for AAA and be automatically placed in the AA Division.
- League Age 10 and 11 year olds may not be considered for Majors and be automatically placed in the AAA Division.
- All League Age 12 year olds who did not play Majors last spring will automatically play Majors per Little League International Rules.
- Please be aware that, in addition to skill level, player placements and the number of teams for Majors and AAA may also be dictated by other factors including Little League International rules for team sizes, the number of qualified pitchers and catchers at each level, etc.

Notes for League Age 5, 6, 7 year olds:

- No skill assessment is required for League Age 5, 6 and 7 year olds.
- League Age 5 year olds will play T Ball.
- League Age 6 year olds will either play T ball or A ball.
 6 year olds must have one year of T Ball before advancing to A Ball.
- League Age 7 year olds will play A Ball (Coach Pitch).
 Typically, children will play only one season of T ball before advancing to A ball the next spring. League Parents of League Age 7 players who have played one year of A Ball may request from the JDLL Board that their son play AA Ball. The Board will review the request and will notify parents of their final decision. The decision is also based upon number of positions available at the AA Ball level.

League Age is the age of your child on August 31, 2023 (Age Calculator: https://www.littleleague.org/play-little-league/determine-league-age/)

Important Notes:

- Failure to attend skill assessment means that your child may not be placed at the appropriate level.
- League Age 8 year olds may not be considered for the Minors Division and be automatically placed in Coach Pitch. League Age 8 year olds will play Coach Pitch if it is determined at the Skill Assessment that is the correct Division for them.
- League Age 10 year olds may not be considered for the Majors Division and be automatically placed in Minors.
- Please be aware that, in addition to skill level, player placements and the number of teams for Majors and Minors may also be dictated by other factors including Little League International rules for team sizes, the number of qualified pitchers and catchers at each level, etc.

Notes for League Age 5, 6, 7 year olds:

- No skill assessment is required for League Age 5, 6 and 7 year olds.
- League Age 5 year olds will play T Ball
- League Age 6 year olds will play either T Ball or Coach Pitch. League Age 6 year olds must have one year of T Ball before advancing to Coach Pitch.
- League Age 7 year olds will play Coach Pitch. Typically, children will play only one season of T ball before advancing to Coach Pitch the next spring.
